

Chris Crabbe responses to 2022 GCS Candidate Survey

Hi Michael,

Thank you for the opportunity to respond to your survey. Please see below:

1.

In principle I support greater funding for community services, including community centres, though any decision would need to be made after appropriate consultation with stakeholders, in addition to a business case being put forward to justify the increase in funding.

2.

I support the appropriate funding being allocated to community centres based on their operating model, end-user outcomes and services provided.

3.

Yes, I think where solar installations can be installed properly on council owned+ /78956 and leased sites that it should subsidise that installation. I think this should be done in tandem with making such sites more energy efficient, incorporating retrofitted sustainable design where possible.

I support no-cost promotion of community centre programs and notices through a multimedia approach, where possible council should promote the activity of community centres through social media, web, and print (Unley Life).

I firmly believe in a genuine and outcome-driven approach to Reconciliation with the First Nations Peoples of Australia. I would support a Kurna Place Naming initiative provided it was done in a culturally safe and appropriate way, in consultation with local Kurna Elders and representatives.

If elected I will explore providing long-term leases to all essential community services (including community centres) to provide an adequate amount of time to allow community services and organisations to undertake (and deliver on) long-term strategic plans.
